
# State-Supported FY-22 Monthly Ridership

- Ridership grew by 21.7% in October (+11,006) compared to the previous month.
- This is consistent with prior years, as ridership on state sponsored service has on an average increased ~19% between September and October.
- Start of Richmond Route-51 and associated promotion may have given a boost to ridership in October 2021.
- For the week ending November 18, Yo2Y 7 day moving average for
  Virginia bookings were at the same level as 2019. By comparison, Amtrak system wide bookings during that same period were down 21.9%.

### Virginia FY22 State Supported Monthly Ridership





## October Ridership Comparison: Yearover-Year

- Ridership for Virginia supported Amtrak service in October 2021 was 81.4% of October 2018 (↓18.6%).
- Virginia ridership in October 2021 lagged by 32.5% compared to October 2019 (pre-pandemic) but was more than double of October 2020.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Norfolk roundtrip had not started in October 2018, but it was operational in October 2019. Richmond route was not operational in October 2020 due to pandemic related service cuts.



# Federal Fiscal Yearto-Date (FFYTD) Ridership: (Oct)

- FFY22 YTD ridership in October for Virginia supported Amtrak service was 18.6% lower compared to FFY19 (pre-pandemic). 2<sup>nd</sup> Norfolk route was had not begun service in October of FFY19.
- FFY22 YTD ridership in October for Virginia supported Amtrak service was 32.5% lower compared to FFY20 (pre-pandemic) but was more than double of last year (October FFY21).
- Please note following pandemic service details: FFY2020 had five pre-pandemic ridership months. Second round-trip trains for both Newport News and Norfolk routes were suspended from April 2020 to September 2020. Richmond Route 51 was not operational from April 2020 to September 26, 2021.
