To better connect statewide Amtrak service to southwestern Virginia, VPRA began a feasibility study in Fall 2021 to examine station locations in the NRV. The Study builds on previous work analyzing the development of a NRV Station for the region, and assesses station location opportunities that are now possible because of the Governor's May 2021 announcement.
