


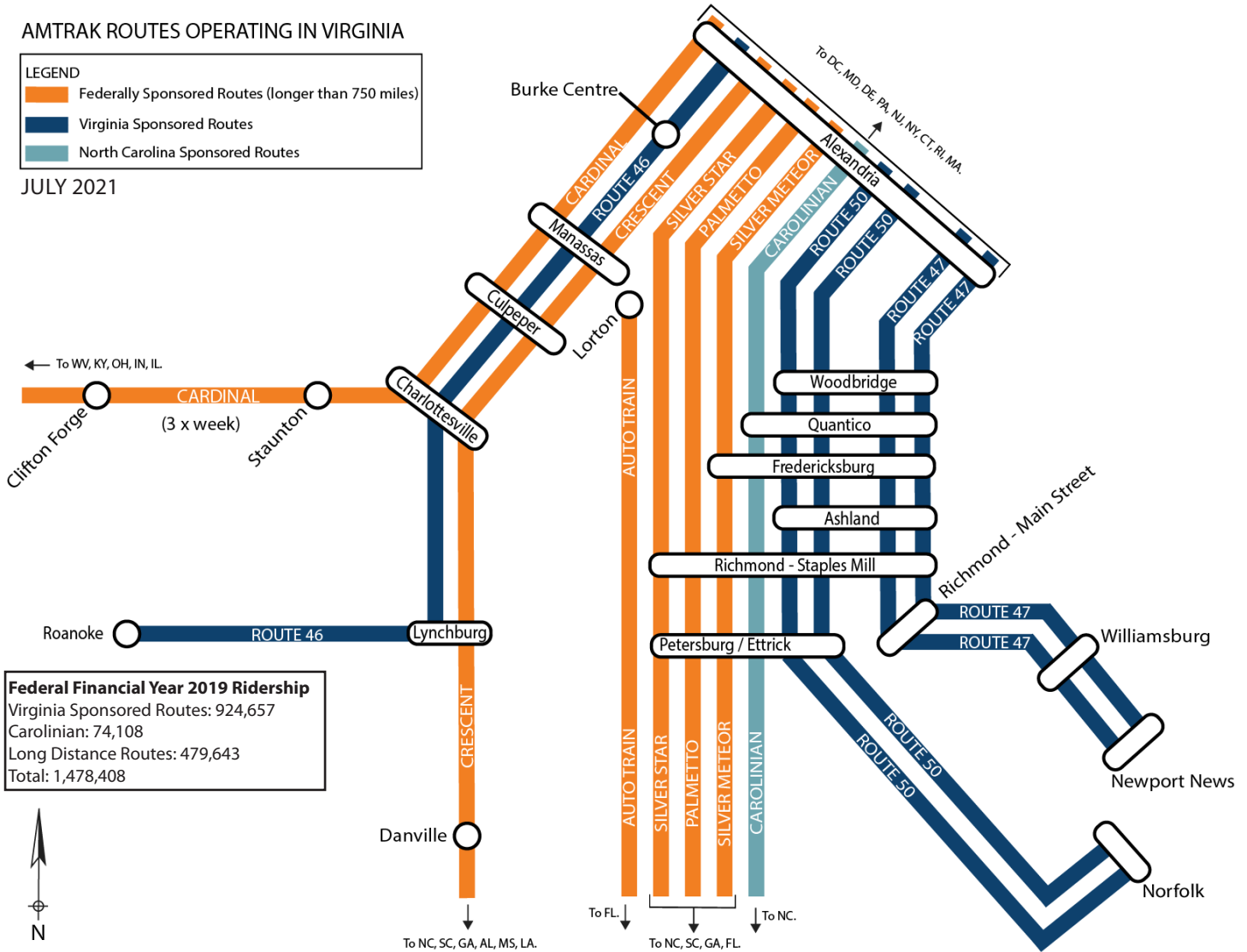

- Notes:
1. Long distance routes Crescent, Palmetto, Silver Meteor, and Silver Star which pass through Virginia were restored to daily (pre-pandemic) schedule on June 7, 2021. Stay at home orders due to COVID-19 went into effect statewide in March 2020. Service reduction on three Virginia sponsored routes was implemented on April 1, 2020. Service was added back incrementally between April and September 2020 based on infection rate and ridership demand.
 2. Service impact on Virginia sponsored routes due to COVID pandemic: Rt. 51*-Washington-Richmond: Suspended (Down from 1 roundtrip. However, Richmond is still served by Norfolk, Newport News and other long distance Amtrak service). Full service is anticipated to resume in 2021 and will depend on increase in demand.
 3. Ridership is the number of individual riders on a route. Ridership fluctuates seasonally and can be affected by holidays, special events, construction, etc.
 4. Station Activity is the combined number of riders getting on or off a train at a station.
 5. On Time Performance (OTP) is the percent of trains arriving at a station within 15 minutes of scheduled arrival time. Weather related slow downs can affect OTP.
