

Federal Fiscal Year-to-Date (FFYTD) (December 2021) On-Time Performance

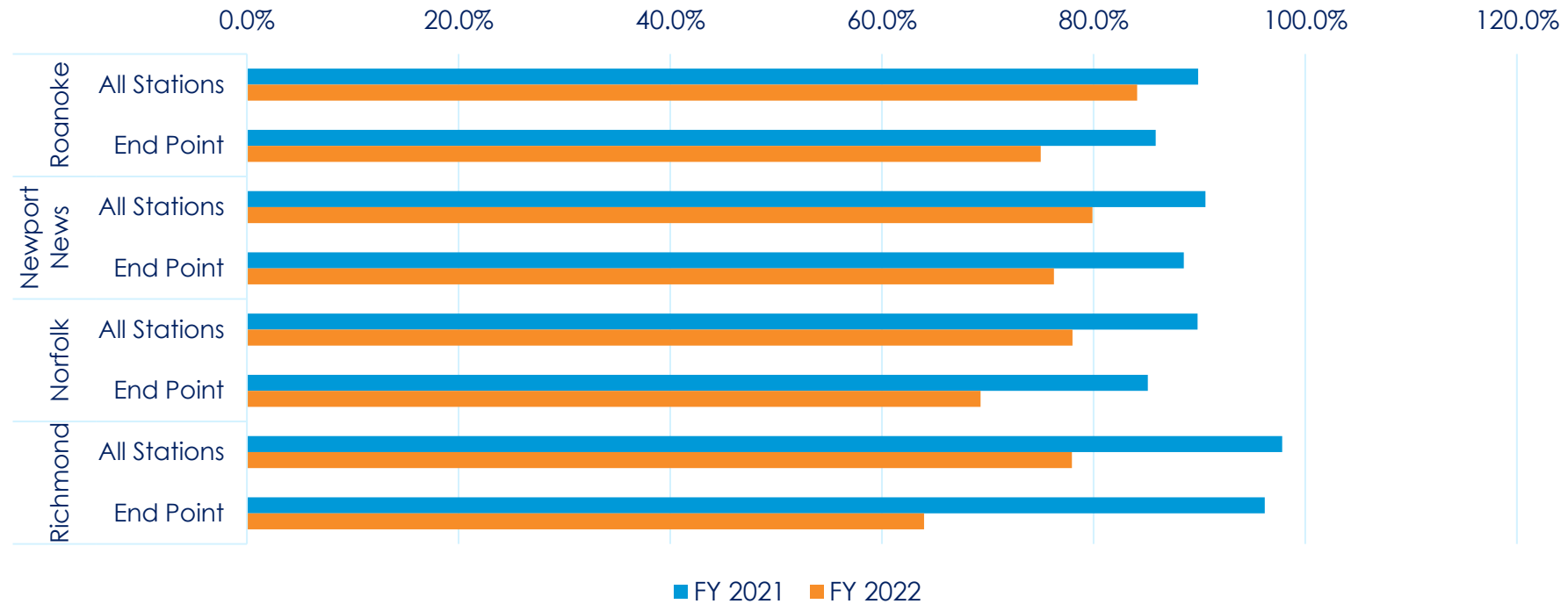
Major delay factors affecting OTP in December 2021 by responsibility are:

- **Host delays:** Commuter and passenger train interference and speed restriction due to defect, slow orders.
- **Amtrak delays:** Car or engine failure, Passenger related except disabled passenger, and miscellaneous delays, loss of time on run.
- **Third party delays:** Waiting on time and weather related.

Host responsible delay was the biggest cause of delayed trains in December.
