VPRA received the following questions electronically:

Question #1: Is the participating firm required to have an office local to Richmond? In a team/JV

situation, are all the individual firms on the team required to have offices in Richmond? Would it be acceptable if the firms have offices elsewhere in the

Commonwealth of Virginia?

Answer #1: There is no requirement that firms have a local office in Richmond. However, the

nature of the work will require onsite presence by key personnel on a periodic and/or recurring basis at VPRA offices in Richmond and Northern Virginia, as well as at job sites located throughout the Commonwealth. Proposals should demonstrate the ability to dispatch key personnel in a timely and cost-efficient manner to meet VPRA's program management needs as outlined in the RFP.

Question #2: Are key personnel in staff augmentation roles required to be physically present at

the VPRA office every day? Is there flexibility of working remotely? If yes, how

many days per week?

Answer #2: Periodically and depending upon the nature of the work, key personnel, including

those functioning in staff augmentation roles, may need to be physically present in VPRA's office. Remote working arrangements are acceptable on a case-by-case basis if such arrangements do not negatively affect responsiveness, timeliness, or

quality of the work.

Question #3: Should the fee proposal be submitted for the prime only, for each firm on the team

in separate forms, or for the entire team in a combined form?

Answer #3: VPRA asks that a separate form be provided for each firm.

Question #4: Can the Authority explain how the fee proposal required as part of the submittal

will be evaluated?

Answer #4: Tab Seven (7) considers if rates are reasonable and appropriate. The

determination will be based on Firm's rates and fees compared to current market

rates and the rates and fees submitted by competing Offerors.

Question #5: Will the team awarded the contract be limited to personnel classifications

submitted in the fee proposal, or will other personnel classifications be permitted as part of the contracting process or later over the course of the contact if the need

for specialty services arises?

Answer #5: Other personnel classifications are allowed.

Question #6: The fee proposal form indicates that there is a footnote by way of a superscript 1

in the Annual Percentage Rate Increase column. Can VPRA advise as to whether

a footnote was intended?

Answer #6: A footnote was not intended. "Superscript 1" is a typo in the fee proposal form.

Question #7: Can a subconsultant support rail construction oversight services for TRV projects

that they are not involved in constructing under other contracts to VPRA, CSXT, Amtrak, or VRE? Additionally, would their involvement preclude them from any VPRA work outside the TRV program of projects (e.g., Buckingham Branch)?

Answer #7:

Matters involving real or perceived organizational conflicts of interest (OCI) will be administered in accordance with VPRA's Organizational Conflict of Interest Policy (the "OCI Policy") which is available on the VPRA website (VPRA-Organizational-Confict-of-Interest-Policy Executed-FINAL Effective-08 24 2022 V1.pdf (vapassengerrailauthority.org)). OCI determinations involve fact specific inquiries and VPRA does not provide advisory opinions involving hypotheticals or generalized statements of fact. To the extent a potential offeror is unclear as to whether an actual, potential, or perceived OCI exists, it should promptly request a written determination from VPRA via electronic mail at procurement@vpra.virginia.gov.

VPRA received the following questions during the optional pre-proposal conference:

Question #1: How will conflicts of interest be handled?

Answer #1: Please go to VPRA's web site and see our Conflict-of-Interest (COI) Policy. Any

Contractor having or potentially having an Organizational Conflict of Interest shall promptly disclose the matter to VPRA. Submit any potential COI in accordance

with our policy and VPRA will answer on case-by-case basis.

Question #2: Have we used this type of contract in the past?

Answer #2: Yes, we have a current TRV Consultant whose contract is expiring.

Question #3: Can you provide the name of current consultant?

Answer #3: Yes, Kimley Horn is the current TRV Consultant.

Question #4: Exhibit I, section IV ids key personnel, must we submit resumes for each? Your

proposal doesn't necessarily need those positions.

Answer #4: Please provide resumes for your core team and the roles you suggest/intend to

use as key personnel. VPRA listed some personnel classifications that may be on firm's proposals. Include the qualifications and experience of program staff/key personnel that will be needed and available to ensure you can deliver on your

methods and approach to providing services.

Question #5: Do you anticipate any federal funds being used on this contract?

Answer #5: Per the RFP, Section 9.0 FEDERAL FUNDING AND REQUIREMENTS; Sub-

Section 9.1: VPRA anticipates receiving federal financial assistance on the Project in the form of a grant from the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA). Accordingly, this procurement shall be subject to all requirements associated with FRA federal

financial assistance.

Question #6: Can we expand on staff augmentation needs?

Answer #6: Yes, please show how you can support working with VPRA as we go into each

project, pull projects together, manage oversight for design and construction, and have timely delivery through Phases 1 &2 of TRV. VPRA is looking to bring in talent

externally as staff augmentation.



- Infrastructure Improvements including New Long Bridge to Expand Rail Service in Virginia
