VIRGINIA ANYTIME FARE

Book anytime and save 15% on trips in Virginia. Available on Northeast Regional trains in Virginia & to D.C.

VIRGINIA STUDENT FARE

Students save 25% in Virginia. Available on Northeast Regional Trains in Virginia and to D.C. Save now through June 2023.

SHARE FARES Save up to 60% on group travel. Valid for up to eight companions.

MILITARY DISCOUNT

Save 10% on all travel for Military personnel and their families.

USA RAIL PASS

The USA Rail Pass is your ticket to tour the country. 10 rides (segments) over 30 days to your choice of over 500 destinations. At just \$499, that's less than \$50 per segment.

GROUP TRAVEL DISCOUNTS

Passengers traveling together in groups of 15 or more may be eligible to receive a discount off the normal rail fare, or a free escort ticket for each 20 travelers. Learn more about group travel requests by calling 1-800-USA-1GRP for more information on taking everyone along to share the fun.

Restrictions may apply on all discounts.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Where can I find the train schedule?

A: Visit us at Amtrak.com/Virginia to find train schedules.

Q: What are the train stations in Virginia?

A: Some of our popular stations are Norfolk, Newport News, Williamsburg, Richmond: Staples Mill and Main Street Station, Fredericksburg, Alexandria, Washington, D.C., Roanoke, Lynchburg and Charlottesville. Go to Amtrak.com/ Virginia to see all stations and destinations.

Q: How do I get to my final destination from the train station?

A: Easily take Uber or Lyft to get to your final destination. Most stations may offer public transit options such as buses or commuter rail.

Q: How many bags can I take with me on the train?

A: You may carry on up to two bags, and two personal items.



Q: What are your discounts?

A: See page 5 for our valuable discounts.

Q: Which discount lets me save the most?

A: The Saver Fare can save the most on individual travel. Saver Fares can be booked at least 21 days in advance to save up to 50%. Periodic flash sales also offer deep discounts, so keep an eye out!

Q: How can I save on a trip this weekend?

A: With our Virginia Anytime Fare, you can save 15% on last minute travel within Virginia and to D.C. Use promo code V552 when booking.

Q: Can I bring my pets on board?

A: Amtrak allows dogs and cats crated up to 20 lbs. with a reservation made in advance. For a small fee.
