



#### **VALUES**



















### Franconia Area Projects Overview

#### Franconia-Springfield Bypass

This project will add a rail bridge to allow passenger trains to cross over the existing CSXT freight tracks and serve passenger platforms on both sides of the tracks.

#### Franconia to Lorton Third Track


This project will add a third mainline track along one of the most heavily traveled parts of the rail corridor between Washington, DC and Richmond, VA.

Accotink Creek  Construct a new railroad bridge adjacent to the existing railroad bridge



# Franconia-Springfield Bypass




The Bypass will remove an existing bottleneck in the rail corridor south of the Franconia-Springfield Station by constructing an elevated rail bridge that will separate passenger trains from the existing CSXT freight track.










### **Next Steps**

- More information about project schedule for design and construction will be known following selection


