#### **CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL**

Chairperson DeBruhl presided and called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. Ms. Douglas called roll and confirmed an in-person quorum was physically present.

## **BOARD CHAIR WELCOME**

Ms. DeBruhl welcomed all in attendance in person and virtually.

Chairperson DeBruhl welcomed two new Board members, Sandy Bushue, and Beth Rhinehart.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Jay Corbalis, with JB Smith, provided public comment. He congratulated VPRA on the increased ridership of Virginia Regional trains. He also noted that there is concern regarding the ongoing Federal budget negotiations, which could impact Amtrak service on the Northeast Corridor.

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#### MOTION TO APPROVE PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

A motion was made by Sharon Bulova and seconded by Rod Hall to approve the previous board meeting minutes from May 25, 2023. The motion was carried unanimously, with the vote in favor cast by Sharon Bulova, Patricia Doersch, Thelma Drake, Rod Hall, Cynthia Moses-Nedd, James Spore, and John Watkins. Sandy Bushue abstained, and Charles Payne and Beth Rhinehart, each participating remotely, were unable to vote on the motion due to technical problems.

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## **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Presented by: DJ Stadtler, Executive Director, Virginia Passenger Rail Authority

Mr. Stadtler presented the Executive Director's report to brief the board about administrative updates, Amtrak performance data, capital project updates, and financial updates for the previous month.

There has been a tremendous ridership increase happening in collaboration with VRE and Amtrak.

Annual Incentive Plan (AIP) goals are on track to be completed by their respective dates, and drafted FY24 AIP goals were reviewed.

SWaM/DBE spend for FY23 showed a 24% usage of SWaM/DBE vendors.

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## **MANAGEMENT RESERVE POLICY**

Presented by Steve Pittard, Virginia Passenger Rail Authority

This policy documents what VPRA has already been doing. The addition of a policy allows the Board to have oversight and increases the transparency into the Management Reserve procedures. A Management Reserve goal of 5% is recommended.

A motion was made by Patricia Doersch and seconded by Sharon Bulova to approve the adoption of the Management Reserve Policy. The motion was carried unanimously, with the

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#### **BYLAW REVISIONS**

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#### NEWPORT NEWS BUDGET ADJUSTMENT

The city of Newport News and VPRA are partnering to construct a replacement passenger train station featuring intermodal connectivity. This funding commitment supports the track, platform, and train service facilities.

A motion was made by Thelma Drake and seconded by James Spore to approve Capital Grant Budget Adjustment for Newport News Station, Platform, and Service Facility Project. The motion was carried unanimously, with the vote in favor cast by Sharon Bulova, Sandy Bushue, John Delandro, Patricia Doersch, Thelma Drake, Rod Hall, Cynthia Moses-Nedd, Charles Payne, Beth Rhinehart, James Spore, and John Watkins.

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#### MOTION FOR CLOSED SESSION

An overview of the Franconia project with renderings was provided. Key scope items were reviewed as well as how VPRA will coordinate with VRE and CSX for this project.

A motion was made by Rod Hall and seconded by Sharon Bulova to authorize VPRA to receive NVTA Grant Funding for the Franconia-Springfield Passenger Rail Bypass project originally awarded to DRPT.
