

Key Scope Items

- New rail bridge
- New retaining walls
- Railroad crash walls
- Embankment fills
- Track installation
- Stormwater management facilities
- Erosion & sediment controls
- Early & enabling work

Bypass South end, view facing North


Requirements

- Maintenance of railroad traffic (70 trains/day)
- Coordinate with VRE F-S Station Project
- Coordinate with VPRA/CSXT 3rd Track Project
- CSXT to perform utility relocations
- CSXT to install signals
- Substantial completion by December 2026
- Small business utilization
- Comply with stakeholder agreements/permits



Bypass Procurement Process


- Procurement milestones for Franconia-Springfield Bypass CM/GC
 - Release Draft RFP June 30, 2023
 - Industry Day July 20, 2023
 - Release Final RFP August 4, 2023
 - Proposals due September 11, 2023
 - Interviews with firms October 16-17, 2023
 - Board workshop November 16, 2023
 - Notice to Award Following Board approval
 - Notice to Proceed Following Board approval
- Five-person review team with significant support from VPRA Procurement and Legal Teams.




Springfield Bypass

Bypass CM/GC Contract


- Compensation
 - Phase 1: Design, Pre-construction, Early Works
 - Cap of ~\$4.8M
 - Actual compensation based on hours incurred
 - Phase 2: Construction
 - Guaranteed maximum price (GMP) negotiated between 60% and 90% design and sufficient derisking achieved
 - Savings split 50/50
- Price Negotiations
 - Opinion of probable construction cost within 90 days after NTP
 - Binding price proposal between 60% and 90% design
 - Open Book reconciliation
 - Independent Cost Estimator (ICE)





CM/GC Contract

- Project Security Package
- Liquidated Damages
- Limited Relief Events
- Construction Warranties





Next Steps

- Board consideration of CM/GC agreement
- VPRA Executive Director to execute CM/GC agreement; staff to issue notice to proceed once conditions satisfied
- Site clearing/early works to start by end of March 2024; full construction to begin in 2024
- Substantial Completion of Construction in 2026
