

Long Bridge Project Scope





The Project corridor is separated into four areas to reflect the varying site conditions and the transition from parkland to an urban context.



North Package Procurement Process

- Procurement milestones for Long Bridge North Progressive Design-Build
 - Industry Day February 24, 2023
 - Release RFQ March 24, 2023
 - Qualifications due May 5, 2023
 - Shortlist announced June 21, 2023
 - Release RFP July 7, 2023
 - Proposals due September 15, 2023
 - Interviews with firms October 11, 2023
 - Board workshop November 16, 2023
 - Notice to Award Following Board approval
 - Notice to Proceed Following Board approval
- VPRA review team with significant support from VPRA Procurement and Legal Teams, as well as the Owner's Rep consultant.



Progressive Design-Build Agreement

- Compensation
 - Phase 1 Design, Pre-construction, Early Works
 - Cap of ~\$39M
 - Actual compensation based on hours incurred
 - Phase 2 Construction
 - Lump sum negotiated after 60% design and sufficient de-risking achieved
- Phase 2 Price Negotiations
 - Opinion of probable construction cost within 90 days
 - Binding price proposal at 60% design
 - Open Book reconciliation
 - Independent Cost Estimator (ICE) and 10% threshold
 - Three-Party Agreement





Progressive Design-Build Agreement, cont.

- Project Security Package
 - Performance Guarantees
 - Performance Bond
- Liquidated Damages
 - Late completion LDs (\$95K / \$26K per day);
 \$100M maximum
- Limited Relief Events
 - 16 events
- Construction Warranties
 - Two years
