





# Virginia Passenger Rail Authority

- Created in 2020 by the General Assembly
- Given all powers necessary for carrying out its statutory purposes:
  - Design, build, finance, and maintain rail facilities
  - Direct recipient of USDOT Grants
  - Eminent domain powers
- Own rail assets and right of way
- Partner with Amtrak and VRE to operate passenger and commuter rail service
- Governed by a 15-Member Board






TRV: Benefits Whole East Coast



## DC to Charlotte: S-Line the Centerpiece

- Direct connection between urban centers – 20M people – estimated to be 25M by 2040
- Additional capacity and over an hour in travel time saved between NC and VA
- Backbone of a regional multi-modal network
- Critical to further expanding the NC passenger rail system
- Provides rail network resiliency
- Environmental benefits
- Expands service to disadvantaged and underserved regions





## **Richmond to Raleigh: S-Line Corridor**

- NCDOT and VPRA in 2022 received a \$58M grant from the FRA for survey and preliminary engineering.
- Corridor photogrammetry/survey underway.
- Community engagement ongoing.
- PE procurement underway.
- While the vast majority of the abandoned S-Line has been acquired from CSXT there are additional non-CSXT owned parcels that need to be acquired.


