# What is the **New River Valley Passenger Rail Project?**

The New River Valley Passenger Rail Project will bring passenger rail service to the region for the first time since 1979.

This project will focus on the rail corridor between Roanoke and the New River Valley (NRV), addressing needs for infrastructure improvements, including track, signaling, tunnels, and a station platform, with the ultimate goal of extending passenger rail service westward.

## **NRV PASSENGER RAIL** STATION AUTHORITY

The NRV Passenger Rail Station Authority was enabled in 2021 by the Virginia General Assembly. This regional entity will lead the construction and maintenance of the future station facility.

### **HISTORY**

Amtrak service to Christiansburg, VA, ends

1979 - - - - - 2013 - - - - - 2017

NRV Passenger Rail community initiative is formed to bring passenger rail service back to the New River Valley

Passenger rail service is re-established between Lynchburg and Roanoke

Virginia Passenger Rail Authority (VPRA) is created to promote, sustain, and expand passenger and commuter rail service in the Commonwealth

#### **MAY 2021**

Agreement with Norfolk Southern Railway (NS) to extend passenger rail service from Roanoke to the NRV is announced

Agreement finalized which includes second train on Roanoke route, extension of trains to NRV, and purchase of 28 miles of track from Salem to Christiansburg


