

What is the Potomac Creek Third Track South project?



Project Status: In engineering design

The Virginia Passenger Rail Authority (VPRRA) is working to improve passenger rail service through Stafford County by building a third railroad track between the Brooke VRE station and the Fredericksburg station. The Potomac Creek Third Track South project will construct approximately four miles of third track near the Leeland Road VRE station. Infrastructure improvements will include reconstruction of the road bridge over the railroad at Leeland Road and a new rail bridge over Harrell Road at Claiborne Run.

The construction of Potomac Creek Third Track South will improve the efficiency and reliability of rail operations to support the planned growth of freight, passenger, and commuter rail traffic in Northern Virginia and the Southeastern United States.
