

Transforming Rail in Virginia Highlights Between Alexandria and the New River Valley

RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND TRACK ACQUISITION

- Purchase and easements for 27 miles of Norfolk Southern-owned Manassas Line right-of-way and track between Alexandria and Manassas (Broad Run)
- Easements, right-of-way, and operating rights between Roanoke, VA, and Radford, VA (N-Line)

SERVICE IMPROVEMENTS

- Extension of two Amtrak Virginia roundtrips between Roanoke and Christiansburg
- Optional Amtrak Virginia roundtrip service between Washington, DC, and Christiansburg, VA (third roundtrip)
- Expansion of VRE service, including evening and weekend service

CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS

- New passenger station and platform in Christiansburg
- New maintenance and storage facility in Radford
- New bypass track in the Roanoke Yard for more efficient train passage
- New 7-mile siding from Nokesville to Calverton
