EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Presented by: DJ Stadtler, Executive Director, Virginia Passenger Rail Authority

DJ Stadtler presented the Executive Director's report to the Board. He reviewed recent VPRA updates, including Amtrak sale dates. Patricia Doersch asked about the impact of sale days, and DJ Stadtler and Steve Pittard responded.

The Norfolk Station Ridership update was reviewed.

Sandy Bushue asked what date VHB was brought on. DJ Stadtler responded.

Mike McLaughlin updated the board on Capital Projects, and Steve Pittard reviewed revenue and investments.

DJ Stadtler reviewed the updated Legal Defense and Indemnification Policy and the update to the VPRA Bylaws.

SERVICE PERFORMANCE UPDATE

Presented by: Jeremy Latimer, Virginia Passenger Rail Authority

Jeremy Latimer shared information with the board regarding train performance, heat orders, train delays, and how these are being mitigated.

Rich Dalton noted that PTC was activated for VRE and will enhance safety and throughput.
