

Rail Improvements in Fairfax County

The Virginia Passenger Rail Authority (VPRA) is leading a program called Transforming Rail in Virginia (TRV). TRV includes several rail improvement projects in south Fairfax County along the existing rail corridor between the Franconia-Springfield VRE Station and Lorton Road. The projects will:

- ✓ Add capacity to serve more passenger and freight trains
- ✓ Improve **quality**, making service more safe, frequent, and reliable
- ✓ Provide additional choice in moving people and goods efficiently

Depending on your location, you may notice:

- Trucks delivering construction materials
- Distant construction noise near the railroad tracks
- Utilization of a 'shoofly', or temporary track onto which trains are diverted, to allow for more daytime construction activities
- Installation of a retaining wall along the railroad tracks near Barry Road
- Grading and retaining wall construction at the tracks behind Loisdale Estates
- Relocation of the sanitary sewer line and installation of a new culvert at Barry Road cul-de-sac
