


#### **PRIIA 209 Agreement Overview**

## Amtrak Virginia "PRIIA 209" Agreement

Section 209 of the Passenger Rail Investment and Improvement Act of 2008 applies to all routes less than 750 miles, i.e. state-supported service.




### Amtrak Service in Virginia

**Eight** daily roundtrips: VA State-supported

**One** daily roundtrip: Carolinian

**Six** daily roundtrips: Amtrak Long-Distance Services



PRIIA 209 Agreement & SAIPRC

- State-Amtrak Intercity Passenger Rail Committee
  - 20 State Agencies 29 routes
  - Comprised of Amtrak, FRA, and States
- Foundation for VPRA to work with Amtrak and other states: Section 209 of the Passenger Rail Investment and Improvement Act (PRIIA)





#### 209 Agreement & State-Supported Service Line

- SAIPRC Role
  - Develop and refine policy
  - Generate annual rates that inform state payments to Amtrak
  - Support State-Amtrak partnership and resolve issues
- VPRA's Service Rights
  - Revenue Management, Customer Experience, Staffing
  - Schedules, Equipment, & Service Levels
- Amtrak Quarterly Meetings
  - Address OTP, Customer Service, and other high priorities
