CALL TO ORDER

Beth Rhinehart called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

MOTION TO APPROVE PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

CLOSED SESSION

Beth Rhinehart reconvened the open session meeting. Upon reconvening the meeting, Charlie Payne made the following statement:

"We are now going to take a roll call vote, and I ask that each member indicate their agreement with the following:
